Aerial Navigation Expertise: Nepalese pilots are trained to navigate challenging terrains, adverse weather conditions, and varied landscapes with precision.


Search & Rescue: Rescue specialists are trained for mountain rescues as well as sling from helicopters. Our Sherpa team organizes ground search and rescue in remote places.

Emergency Medical Expertise: We have full coordination and access with a wide network of hospitals with modern equipment. In addition, we have a selection of expert doctors and medical team as per the required case.

Effective Coordination: We have established seamless communication channels among team members, ground crews, and authorities. Where needed, we use satellite phone on a timely basis for prompt and effective service.

ALPINE RESCUE SERVICE IN NUMBERS




REGIONS OF RESPONSE


